Torture Methods:

- Electric shock;
- Sleep deprivation;
- Long-term squatting;
- Long-term solitary confinement;
- Hanging;
- “Tying the ropes”;
- Brainwashing.

“Tying the Ropes”

1. **Hanging:** The practitioner is hung, often by his handcuffed wrists, from heating pipes or from a window frame. Usually his toes can barely touch the ground, causing him great pain and bleeding as the handcuffs cut deeply into his flesh.
2. **“Tying the ropes”:** Ropes are wound tightly around the practitioner’s arms, causing a lack of blood circulation. Then the hands are pulled tightly behind the back and tied there. When used for an extended period of time, the victim’s muscles can atrophy and the arms become disabled.

A Special Case:

1. **Ms. Li Huiqi 李慧琪**, born in 1967, worked at the Shijiazhuang Paint Factory in Hebei Province. On December 2, 2001, police from the Weiming Street Police Station in Shijiazhuang City arrested her. On February 2, 2002, after being illegally detained at Shijiazhuang First Detention Center for two months, she was sent to the Second Squad, Fourth Brigade of the Shijiazhuang Forced Labor Camp for a one-year term. She was brutally tortured in the labor camp. When she was released on December 13, 2002, she was completely paralyzed and was not able to take care of herself.

Her two sisters, **Ms. Li Huijie 李慧杰** and **Ms. Li Huixin 李慧欣**, have been repeatedly persecuted since July 1999, because they also practice Falun Gong.

Victim List:

1. **Ms. Li Xiumin 李秀敏**, 44, was employed in the Continuing Education Department at Hebei University of Science and Technology. In July 2004, Ms. Li was arrested and sentenced to forced labor. She is currently serving a two-year term at the Shijiazhuang City Forced Labor Camp. Ms. Li appears to have symptoms of low blood pressure, and her life is in great danger.
2. **Ms. Zhang Limin 张利民** is the executive officer of Kaiping District People's Court in Tangshan City, Hebei Province. She was arrested at her home on October 19, 2004, and sentenced to three years of forced labor. She was first detained in the Kaiping Labor Camp, then transferred to the Shijiazhuang Labor Camp on June 2, 2005. Ms. Zhang has been brutally persecuted in both labor camps and her health is in critical condition right now. She has had two heart attacks since June 2005.
3. **Ms. Qie Lili 郟丽莉**, 27, is a teacher at the Xili Elementary School, Shijiazhuang City, Hebei Province. On February 27, 2004, Ms. Qie was arrested and taken to the Weiming Police Station. She was sentenced to three years of forced labor and



is now detained in the Shijiazhuang Labor Camp. Her health has deteriorated dramatically due to the continuous persecution and torture. She is extremely weak.

4. **Pang Wendong 庞文东** is from Qian'an City, Hebei Province, and as of October 27, 2005, had been detained in the monitor room on the second floor of the labor camp for over a month.
5. **Ms. Liu Ling 刘玲**, 23 years old, is a student in the Department of Chemistry at Handan Normal Collage, Hebei Province. Ms. Liu was arrested several days before October 1, 2004, and was detained in the No. 2 Handan Detention Center for over ten months. On August 18, 2005, she was sentenced to three years of forced labor and sent to the Shijiazhuang Labor Camp.
6. **Mr. Li Jiangan 李建刚** is a resident of Chengguan Town, Luquan City, Hebei Province. On December 20, 2004, Mr. Li's wife, Ms. Dong Xiuzhong, and another Falun Gong practitioner Jia Yulian were arrested while they were distributing Falun Gong materials. Mr. Li was sentenced to three years of forced labor and sent to the Shijiazhuang Labor Camp.
7. **Mr. Tao Hongsheng 陶洪升**, male, 46, worked in the Security Department of Hebei Province. His home address is the No. 2 Dormitory Building, Apartment 2-501, Security Department, Hebei Province; Tel.: 0311-3618132. On December 26, 1999, Mr. Tao went to Beijing to appeal for the right to practice Falun Gong. He was arrested and sentenced to three years in a labor camp. He was detained in the 2nd Brigade of Shijiazhuang Labor Camp and subjected to inhumane torture. His health quickly deteriorated. On September 17, Mr. Tao was on the verge of death, so he was sent back home, where he passed away on September 20, 2000.
8. Mr. Tao's wife, **Yu Fengyun 于风云**, 52 years old, is also a Falun Gong practitioner and had been detained many times and persecuted repeatedly. They have two daughters, **Tao Lili 陶丽丽**, 24 years old, and **Tao Yufei 陶宇菲**, 20 years old.
9. **Mr. Wei Chaozong 卫朝宗**, approximately 40 years old at the time of his death, was a Falun Gong practitioner from Suning County, Cangzhou Area, Hebei Province. He was arrested and sent to the Shijiazhuang Forced Labor Camp on



May 1, 2002. He suffered three months of brutal persecution at the labor camp. He was released when he was on the verge of death. He died at home on August 10, 2002. At the time of his death, his wife, **Du Yuqi** 杜玉芹, was detained in the Cangzhou No. 2 Detention Center. In October 2002, the Yunhe Area Court sentenced her to eight years in prison. She is now held at the Taihang Prison of Mancheng County, Baoding Area, Hebei Province (mailbox 04, sub-mailbox 202, Postal Code: 072150). Their two daughters, **Wei Jiao** 卫姣, 16, and **Wei Wan** 卫婉, 10, are now living in the Special Child Rescue and Research Center in Sun Village in Beijing.
